EMS DRESS CODE

Student dress shall be neat, clean, and within the bounds of decency, health, and safety. Dress and appearance is the responsibility of the parent and the student; however; dress and appearance shall not be disruptive to the educational process or learning objectives. Students need to dress appropriately to learn. A student who wears clothing that disrupts the educational process will be referred to an administrator (see district policy #3224).

Dress Code Detail:

- 1. Clothing that is not normally worn to school, such as pajamas, will not be allowed unless ASB has approved a special "dress day".
- 2. Shoes must be worn at all times, platforms 2" and over and slippers are not to be worn at school.
- 3. Shirts/blouses/tops of dresses:
 - a. Cannot expose midriff, back, bra, or cleavage.
 - b. Cannot be see-through.
 - c. Cannot have suggestive or offensive wording or pictures.
 - d. Cannot advertise gangs, unlawful products or unlawful activities.
 - e. Cannot be halter or tops without shoulder straps.
 - f. Cannot have a neckline that is lower than armpit level.
 - g. Cannot display shoulder straps less than 3 inches wide.
- 4. Pants and shorts:
 - a. Cannot be see-through and must be worn so that underwear cannot be seen.
 - b. Shorts must have an inseam of at least 6 in.
 - c. Any holes must be lower than an inseam of 6 in..
- 5. Skirts/dresses:
 - a. Cannot be see-through
 - b. Must be longer than what an inseam of 6 in. would be.
- Students are not allowed to wear any gang-related items. (See Gang Related Activities policies and Ephrata School District policy #3224).
- 7. No sunglasses, hoods or bandannas (not including hair bands worn in building).
- Any item of clothing or accessory deemed to be a health or safety hazard, or a learning distraction to others, will not be allowed. Trench coats are not allowed. Chains are not allowed.
- 9. Clothing and/or accessories displaying or making reference to alcohol, illicit drugs, tobacco, or clothing displaying profane vulgar, discriminatory or sexual language or pictures shall not be worn.
