

## Registration Declaration of Intent to Provide Home-Based Instruction

A parent who intends to cause their child or children to receive home-based instruction in lieu of attendance or enrollment in a public school, approved private school or an extension program of an approved private school, must file an annual declaration of intent to do so in the format prescribed below:

I do hereby declare that I am the parent, guardian or legal custodian of the child(ren) listed below; and that said child(ren) is (are) between the ages of 8 and 18 and as such, are subject to the requirements found in <a href="RCW 28A.225">RCW 28A.225</a>, Compulsory Attendance; I intent to cause said child(ren) to receive home-based instruction as specified in <a href="RCW 28A.225.010(4">RCW 28A.225.010(4)</a>; and, if a certificated person will be supervising the instruction, I have indicated this by checking the appropriate space.

## TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN INTERSCHOLASTIC CONTESTS OR COMPETITION, THE <u>HOME-BASED</u> INSTRUCTION STUDENT MUST:

- 1. Meet <u>WIAA and school district eligibility requirement standards</u> required of all other students (Link goes to: https://wiaa.com/mywiaa/subcontent.aspx?SecID=1266);
- 2. Meet and adhere to the same team responsibilities and standards of behavior and performance of other members of the team / squad;
- 3. Participate as a member of the public school that the student would normally attend;
- 4. Provide to the school administration acceptable documentation of "full time attendance," academic achievement standards and any other interscholastic eligibility standards required of all other student-participants;
- 5. Comply with WIAA and local school district regulations during the time of participation;
- 6. Are from an approved Home-Based Instruction in compliance with RCW 28A.27.010(4); and
- 7. Provide to school authorities all required forms and provisions.
